Individual delegation goals handed out during ballot, remember: Overall Group Goal is:

Each participant needs to keep in mind that you can't go home to your constituency or country without having achieved a conference statement - they sent you to this meeting to thrash out a statement that makes you look like a good global citizen, but that also aligns as far as possible with your constituency/country values and aspirations. Therefore you may have two competing goals that you must resolve. Here is your overall group goal:

To negotiate a statement on the urgency of tackling climate change that (a) reflects the latest (2007) IPCC assessment and (b) includes a commensurate realistic response, taking into account global economic circumstances and differences. To set a global target on GHG emissions for the 2030-2034 period that will avoid dangerous climate change (with 90% or higher confidence). Note: GHG emissions should be expressed as CO2 equivalent (ie the total emissions with other gases converted to CO2 equivalent, CO2e)

To produce conference media statements before and at conclusion of conference and also a final conference statement.
